MARIA GELI AWARD

The **Consell General (Parliament) of the Principality of Andorra** organises the *Maria Geli* Award with the aim of promoting educational innovation and enriching the existing cultural and pedagogical baggage, by promoting the recognition of Andorra as an international benchmark in the field of education.

The **Maria Geli Award** is a biennial award aimed at professionals or teams of professionals in education working with pupils up to 18 years of age, who have created and carried out experiences of educational innovation in educational institutions both internationally and nationally.

This award was created with the intention of paying tribute to Ms. Maria Geli as a reference in the field of education and pedagogy in our country who, as the first principal of the Andorran School, throughout her professional career became an expert in multilingualism, language teaching and development of teaching materials, always transmitting her knowledge and appreciation for Andorra, striving for greater social cohesion and working to build a quality public school.

Call for applications 2024-2026:

The announcement encompasses two categories:

- **The international category**, for which all national and international participants are eligible, with a prize of **€12,000**.
- **The national category**, which is only open to participants residing in Andorra who have carried out the educational experience in an educational institution in the Principality of Andorra, with a prize of **€3,000**. *

* In the event that the Prize in the international category is awarded to a resident in Andorra, the Prize in the national category will be declared void by the Jury.
